Scope of Review

- Self-assessment of the effectiveness of the implementation of the New gTLD Program by ICANN staff
- Areas of review:
 - Program operations
 - Applicant Support Program
 - Application processing
 - Application evaluation
 - Contention resolution
 - Objection/dispute resolution
 - Contracting and transition to delegation





Methodology

- Review and analysis will be performed for each review area against 6 dimensions:
 - Efficiency
 - Effectiveness
 - Fairness
 - Predictability
 - Security and stability
 - Alignment with policy and implementation guidance

Root Stability

- ICANN commitment to assessing impact of the New gTLD Program on the security and stability of the DNS
 - Studies undertaken previously to consider elements including the size of the root zone, the rate of change, the impact on provisioning systems, impact of other technologies
- Review to examine any issues identified
- Identify any additional steps that should be undertaken for the Program
- Targeted to begin by Q2 2015

- New mechanisms for the New gTLD Program:
 - Trademark Clearinghouse
 - Uniform Rapid Suspension system (URS)
 - Post-Delegation Dispute Resolution Procedures
- Review in progress incorporating:
 - Statistics
 - Input from service providers
 - Customer service questions
 - Media reports
 - User feedback

GNSO-driven Review

• The GNSO developed the base set of policies for the last round of new gTLDs. Current process is to determine whether we need to add new policies or change policies.

First Step: Issue Identification

 The "Discussion Group" is a prelude to the normal GNSO policy develop process. We are developing the issues that will form the basis for any GNSO-initiated policy development work.

Competition, Consumer Trust, and Consumer Choice (CCT) Review

- Reviews anticipated in the Affirmation of Commitments
- IAG-CCT formed to discuss 70 GNSO- and ALACrecommended metrics
- Final report submitted to Board and recommends:
 - Adopting 65 metrics
 - Deleting 5 metrics
 - Adding one metric on name collisions






CCT Review

- Adopted metrics include funds for global Internet user and registrant survey; and an economic study of pricing and marketing practices in new gTLDs
- Remaining metrics include data on registration numbers, compliance cases, Service Level Agreements, and use of rights protection mechanisms
- Baseline data anticipated in Q1 2015
