




DPRD Purpose

Localization and Language Services: Current Work

- A snapshot of the work Language Services currently carries out:
 - In July, Language Services translated almost 780,000 words requested by staff
 - At ICANN50, we provided interpretation to 90 sessions
 - Currently, we are running a focus group looking at content translation for the new ICANN.org





Education: Current Work



- Since starting in November 2013, the Online Learning Platform (OLP) ICANN LEARN has 27 courses- half of which were requested by the community.
- There are more than 900 monthly active users and 9,000 lessons viewed each month on ICANN Learn.
- In addition, DPRD conducts local Academic Outreach at our meetings
